Drylining Fixing & Finishing NVQ Level 2 (Specialist Apprenticeship Programme)

Mortimore Enterprises Ltd in Partnership with ConstructionSkills

Following on from the successful delivery of the industry approved Drylining Apprenticeship in Partnership with ConstructionSkills in 2008, we pleased to announce that we will be running the same course again in 2009.

The next course, which will begin in September 2009 will consist of 15 weeks of off the job training which will be spent at the Mortimore Enterprises Ltd Training Centre in Liverpool. Along with the 12 weeks of occupational training, the course will also include a one week Induction course and a week ensuring that the Key Skills element of the Apprenticeship Framework is covered and a further week at the end of the course to complete the end of course assessments/tests. The off the job training is delivered in a block release pattern with the remainder of the time in the first and second year of training spent on site where work evidence will be collected to achieve the NVQ level 2. There is no off the job training in the second year.

In scope CITB ConstructionSkills registered companies will be eligible to claim full apprenticeship grants over a two year period and the programme will consist of the 22 industry agreed training modules developed by the FPDC and the Drylining Sector in partnership with ConstructionSkills which are shown below.

- Setting out using water levels and Laser Instruments
- Construction of Door & Window Openings
- Design & Selection of Suitable Systems
- Abutments of Partitions
- Services Penetrations
- Understanding and Constructing Deflection Heads
- Construction of Control Joint Details Partitions
- Understanding Construction of Metal Stud: Twin & Staggered Stud
- Understanding Design & Construction of Over Height Partitions & Part Boarded Walls
- Design & Construction of Shaft Wall and Stairwell Systems
- Design & Construction of Drylining Systems
- Repairs & Alterations to Plaster Board Systems
- Introduction to Jointing
- Skimming
- Health & Safety Awareness Training
- Identifying, Storing & Handling Resources
- Maintenance & Safe Use of Hand and Power Tools
- Erection & Dismantling of Basic Working Platforms
- Mobile Towers Training & PASMA Certification
- Safe Use of Gas & Cartridge Powered Tools
- Completion of the NVQ level 2 in year two as either Fixing or Finishing Dryliner
- 15 weeks in total of off the Job Training
